After the meal, anyone who wishes can participate in a Remembrance Night - coming



Across Finland (Europe) and the Nordic countries there is a tradition of communities coming together sometime between November and January and going to the local cemetery to bring candles to the graves of loved ones. After discussing this idea with several interested community members we have decided to incorporate this practice into our Community Thanksgiving!

Before our community Thanksgiving Dinner, we will bring a candle to the Crystal Bay Cemetery and extend an invitation to our community ancestors to join us for dinner. We will then bring that candle to the community center where folks will be invited to light a candle for their loved ones and bring it to their table. After the meal, those who want to participate will bring their candles to the Crystal Bay Cemetery to bring their candles to loved ones' graves (there will also be a place to leave candles for folks who are not buried in the Crystal Bay Cemetery).

Folks will gather at the Crystal Bay Cemetery at 6pm, bringing candles to the gravesites of loved ones. People can bring their own candle lanterns but there will also be some provided. The hope is to spend some time there, sharing stories of the folks who are no longer with us, and the "good old days" in Finland, MN.


